U12: Aug. 1, 1999 to July 31, 2002 (see above; the league reserves the right to place kids on u10 or u12)

U14: Aug. 1, 1997 to July 31, 1999; though U15 not playing on a high school team can play U14, Fall only.

U18: Aug. 1, 1993 to July 31, 1997 only for kids not playing on a high school team in the Spring.
